Taking Care of Your New Growler

This growler is a great way to transport your favorite brew and should provide years of service if you follow these simple steps:

1. Rinse several times with hot water as soon as it gets empty and leave it upside down to dry. (step no. 1 for a reason)
2. If you messed up step 1 and you have a gross growler; start with a bottle brush then detergent in warm water and a super hot water rinse. Repeat until it passes the nose test.
3. If you are visiting your local establishment for a refill, request a sanitizing rinse first.
4. If you are a homebrewer, bottle condition at your own risk. Handmade products can't be pressure rated consistently or reliably.
5. Don't forget to ask yourself WWBJD? The answer is to enjoy responsibly, of course!
